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Rancheroni & Cheese With Buttermilk, Buffalo, and Bacon



Bring buttermilk and water to a boil, stirring to prevent buttermilk breakup. Add noodles. Boil until just past al dente, about 6 minutes and noodles have absorbed most liquid.

Reduce heat.

Finely chop herbs. Cook, then dice bacon. Grate cheeses separately. Stir-in American cheese with noodle mixture until melted. Add the herbs, ranch powder, cayenne, and bacon. Remove from heat. Add the Vermont cheddar, stirring lightly but allowing it to melt on its own. Season to taste with salt and pepper. If mixture dries out, stir in a 1/4 cup buttermilk.

In a small pan, mix panko and a pinch of salt with olive oil and heat until browned.

Serve in a bowl, top with panko and garnish with a sprig of dill. Add a dozen dashes of Crystal hot sauce. Enjoy.

This ranch-themed Mac 'n Cheese is a variation of America's Test Kitchen's simple stove top macaroni. Their innovations include not straining (allowing the starch of the noodles to support the texture of the sauce) and using American cheese from the deli counter. This cheese is the special trick of this recipe, because it is full of emulsifiers that prevent the cheese from breaking apart at high heat. So don't skimp on it, and don't buy it sliced. Get it from the deli counter. It's also important to weigh your pasta since the liquid will be absorbed.

To ranchify this recipe we use buttermilk, fresh herbs, and typical ranch seasoning. To get that buffalo flare, we simply use Crystal brand hot sauce. Though buffalo sauce would be fine.

11/2 cup water

1 cup buttermilk

8ºz elbow macaroni

4°z white American cheese (from deli counter, not shelf)

4° Vermont sharp cheddar

11/2 tsp chives

11/2 tsp cilantro

1 oz Panko

1/2 oz bacon

1 Tbsp ranch powder

Pinches of cayenne

Dill sprigs for garnish

Crystal brand hot sauce


The KråkStik

When I first entered "Old Timers & Chimers Clocks Shop" at 409 S 9th Street in Opelika, Alabama, I was immediately struck with the smell of the place. Those who follow the trickers closely know about that infamous day. At 12 on December 3rd I was flabbergasted - the trickers performed their biggest trick yet on an unlucky group of construction workers in Meridian, Mississippi.

That was all the confirmation I needed. I was talking to one of the trickers. I didn't hear from tricker 1 again until a year and a half later. His next message read "Meet us in the backroom at "Old Timers & Chimers Clocks Shop at 409 S 9th Street in Opelika, Alabama tomorrow at 8:00am." That was all I needed to get me into the car and speeding towards the state line.

I was headed into the backroom where the trickers told me to meet them when I realized that the doorway at the back of the shop did not lead to any backroom. I pushed it open to reveal the alleyway outside and it dawned on me that the Old Timers & Chimers Clocks Shop showroom was the entire inside of the building. I looked back at the old man who stood in the corner of the room when I entered, but he was gone. Then it hit me - I had been tricked.
